WALLS AND HISTORY

SUBJECTS: GERMAN AS SECOND FOREIGN LANGUAGE + ART

COUNTRIES: POLAND, THE NETHERLANDS AND SPAIN

LEVEL : Students of German as Second Foreign Language (15-16 years old)

LANGUAGE:

German + native languages

GOALS:

- to enrich the knowledge of the German language
- To deepen into European history
- to implement cooperative work among students of different nationalities

ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION:

1. The Berlin Wall

In this first phase students are due to work on the following matters:

- Historical background
- Building process of the Wall
- Notorious events
- Fall of the Wall
- The Berlin Wall today and the East Side Gallery

(NOV-DEC 2017)

2. 1961 -1989 in Poland, Spain and The Netherlands

Students should now get to know the historical events that took place in their own countries during the period the Wall was standing

(JANUAR 2018)

3. Multimedia Presentation

In this presentation students should go through points 1 and 2 and explain them (German+ Polish/German-Spanish)

(FEBRUAR 2018)

4. The Wall

Students paint their own wall (or a simulation of wall) on which they express how they understand the studied facts in points 1 and 2 .

(APRIL 2018)

* The students of each country will record the developing process of the different phases and make a Film so that, at the end of the school year, we can compile the videos and create a new film with the different sequences of all the countries involved.

*We are now thinking of the possibility of a trip to Berlin in June 2018. The students could then meet together,

visit the East Side Gallery and conclude the project with a live outdoor learning experience.
